In 1978, we opened the doors to our adult facility, where aging and disabled individuals 18 years and older can receive loving, supervised care during the day.

Preschool and daycare.

Our year-round preschool and daycare gives every child the opportunity to grow emotionally, socially and intellectually, in an inclusive, multi-cultural and intergenerational environment. We are the only non-profit, state-licensed center in Utah to achieve NAEYC (National Association for the Education of Young Children) accreditation. Our nurturing environment is engaging and stimulating, preparing young children for success in school.

Youth programs.

Our youth programs give kids ages 5-15 a safe, fun and supportive place to be while not in school. This includes time before and after school for elementary age children (with transportation to and from school) and all day during the summer for kids up to age 15. Our curriculum provides wonderful opportunities for our youth to expand

their learning, increase their confidence, become involved with the community, and acquire the tools they need to succeed.

Adult day program.

Our house provides a safe and caring environment for adults who need supervised care during the day. Each client receives the emotional, cognitive, physical and social stimulation needed to encourage independence, prevent isolation and avoid premature placement in long-term care facilities. We also give caregivers a much-needed respite and the ability to continue working. We provide transportation, medical assistance, referrals to community resources and nutritious meals.
